- **Article Authorship**
  - Designees can earn continuing education for articles for industry related publications. A copy of the published work must be submitted with the AMS redesignation form, or a link provided if the online redesignation process is used. Hours will be awarded based on the following:
    - 500–1,000-word article: 2 hours
    - 1,001–1,500-word article: 3 hours
    - 1,500+: 4 hours
  - *Being interviewed for an article does not count for this option.*
- **Speaking/Teaching Hours**
  - 1 hour of presenting = 1 CE hour
- **Volunteer Service**
  - Hours may be earned for volunteer service to organizations whose mission pertains to community associations or the management profession. Designees cannot receive compensation for any activities for which they report. The following service activities can be counted towards continuing education hours:
    - National/International Board: 8 hours
    - State Chapter Board: 4 hours
    - Committee: 4 hours
    - HOA/Condo Board: 4 hours
- **An Additional M-200 Level or Above Course**
  - Another M-200+ course can be used toward the 8 hours (not recommended long-term)
  - The M-200 level courses must be completed prior to the August 1 deadline, regardless of when you register for them.
